

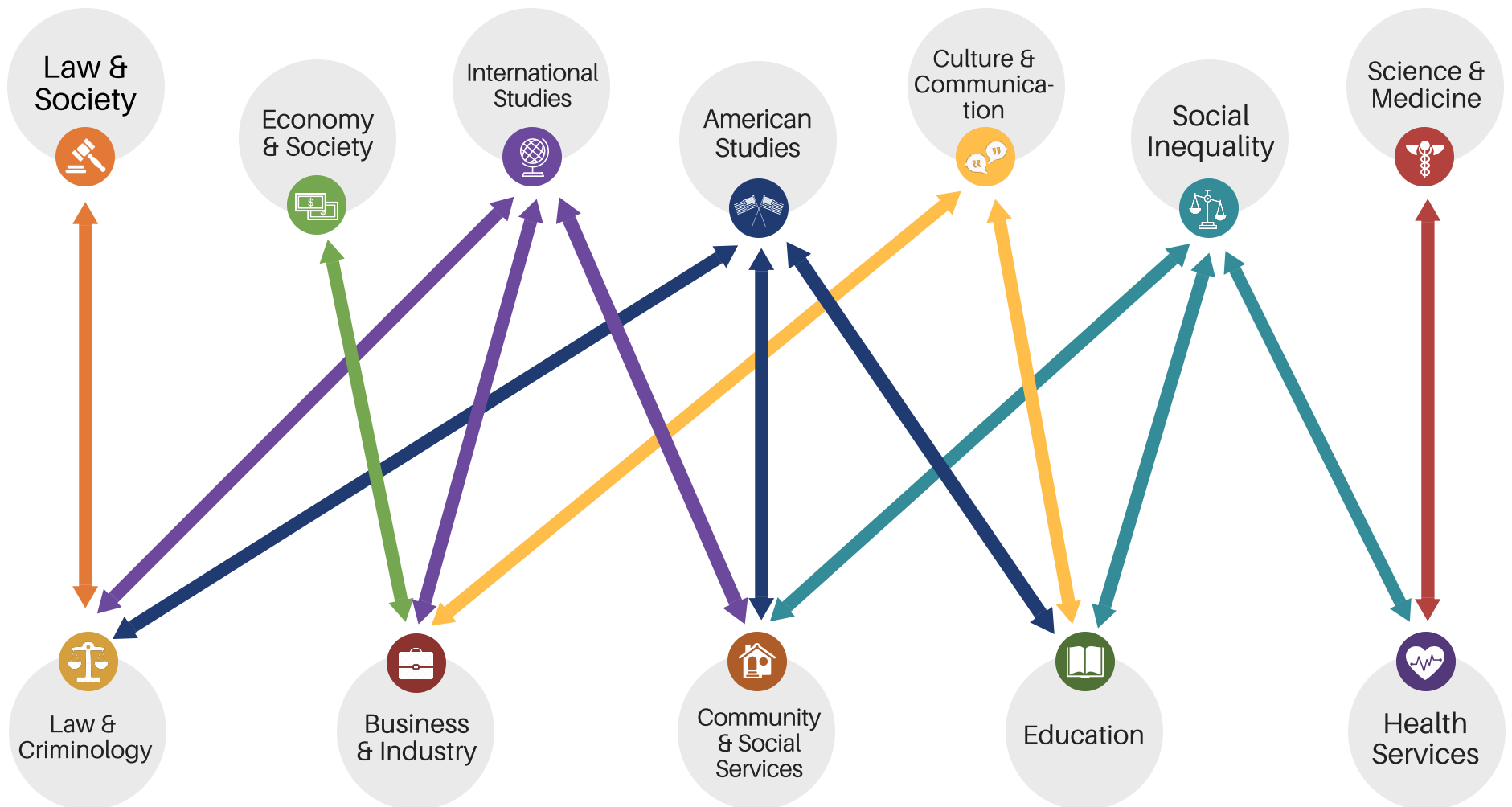


Career Paths
