

The completed application must be in the Undergraduate Coordinator's office no later than the end of week five in the spring quarter prior to the start of the fall-winter honors program. GPA's, both overall and in the major, will be calculated after spring quarter grades have been recorded. Students will be notified in July whether or not they have been accepted into the program.

UCSD SOCIOLOGY HONORS PROGRAM

The Sociology Department offers an Honors Program to those students who have demonstrated excellence in the sociology major. Successful completion of the Honors Program enables the student to graduate "**With Highest Distinction**," "**With High Distinction**," or "**With Distinction**," depending upon their performance in the program.

Eligibility Requirements

- Junior or Senior Standing. (90 units to be completed prior to the program's start date)
- Sociology Major GPA must be at least 3.5, and the overall GPA must be at least 3.2. These GPA requirements *must be maintained until graduation*.
- Recommendation by faculty members familiar with student's work. (You do *not* need to attach letters of recommendation. We will provide a short questionnaire to the professors listed on your application.)
- Must have completed at least four upper-division sociology courses by the end of spring quarter prior to the program's start date.
- SOCI 100, *Classical Sociological Theory*, and one upper-division "method" course must be completed prior to the start of the Honors Program.
- Must submit a half page statement with a description of your research topic along with a ten-item bibliography with this honors application.
- Must obtain a faculty advisor to work with prior to the start of the fall-winter Honors Program. (If needed, the Undergraduate Coordinator or the Director of Undergraduate Studies will help refer you to an appropriate faculty advisor for your project.)
- Submission of writing sample (e.g., term paper, take home exam)

Program Requirements

Fall quarter, students take Sociology 196A, *Advanced Studies in Sociology*. Winter quarter, students take Sociology 196B, *Supervised Thesis Research*. Grades are recorded as IP (in progress) at the end of fall quarter. At the completion of the program, (winter quarter), the grade received will apply to both seminars. To graduate "With Highest Distinction" the student must earn an **A+**; to graduate "With High Distinction" the student must earn an **A**; and to graduate "With Distinction" the grade must be an **A-**.

Seminar Descriptions

SOCI 196A - Advanced Studies in Sociology This seminar will permit honors students to explore advanced issues in the field of sociology. It will also provide honors students with the opportunity to develop a senior thesis proposal on a topic of their choice and begin preliminary work on the honors thesis under faculty supervision.

SOCI 196B - Supervised Thesis Research This course will provide honors candidates with an opportunity to complete the research on and final preparation of a senior honors thesis under close faculty supervision.
